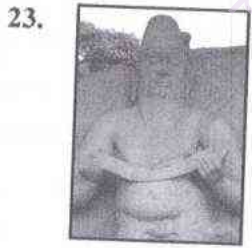

 4. Understanding the principles (perspective, three dimensional qualities, eye level and use of space) (05 marks)
 5. Use of colour and characteristics. (05 marks)
 6. Background of the art work and overall finish. (05 marks)
